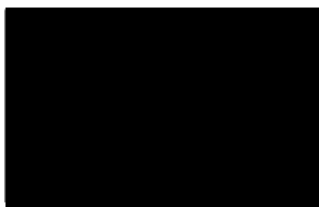
Please note that under Associated Development and the Delivery Routes headings, Horizon are looking to improve the A5025 corridor – not the A55.

Cumulative Impact Assessment Chapter

- Section 17.8 notes that both Projects will be utilising the A5. HNP's route for construction traffic will be the A55 and A5025 from Valley to Wylfa.
- 17.8.21 would Anglesey fall under the study area for up-skilling a long with Gwynedd and Conwy. There is a large amount of resource pooling in terms of construction employment and this could be a cumulative effect.
